Continuation of studies (permanència)

- ✓ Students can register up to three times per course. No grade, failing, non assessable (no evaluable) imply you have exhausted registration rights
- ✓ 30 credits must be obtained over two years
- ✓ In order to register for the second year, 12 credits must have been obtained
- ✓ In order to register for the third year, 60 credits corresponding to the first and second year must have been obtained
- ✓ Students must enrol on basic or mandatory subjects or modules before enrolling on new ones
- ✓ Students are allowed to validate (waive) one subject if, and only if, the student has enrolled 3 times in the course, and has got a minimum of 3.5 /10 in at least in one of the occasions



Student workload

ECTS (*European Credit Transfer System*) imply changes in study and learning practices. ECTS are based on students' work. Each ECTS implies 25 Student hours

Therefore, a 6 ECTS course means, on the whole, 150 Student hours, spread over a 13/14 week period

In class hours imply 1/3 of students' time, the remaining 2/3 belong out of class - 1 hour of class = 2 hours out of class

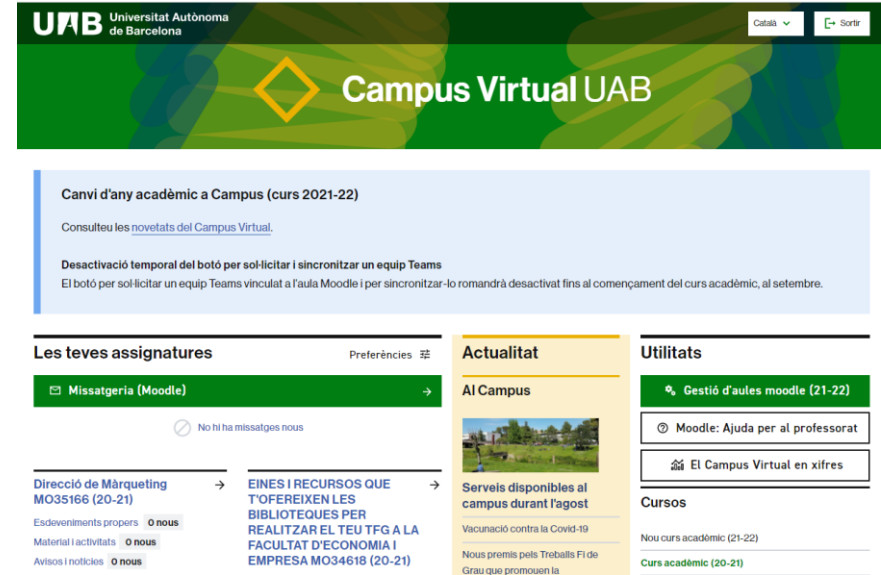
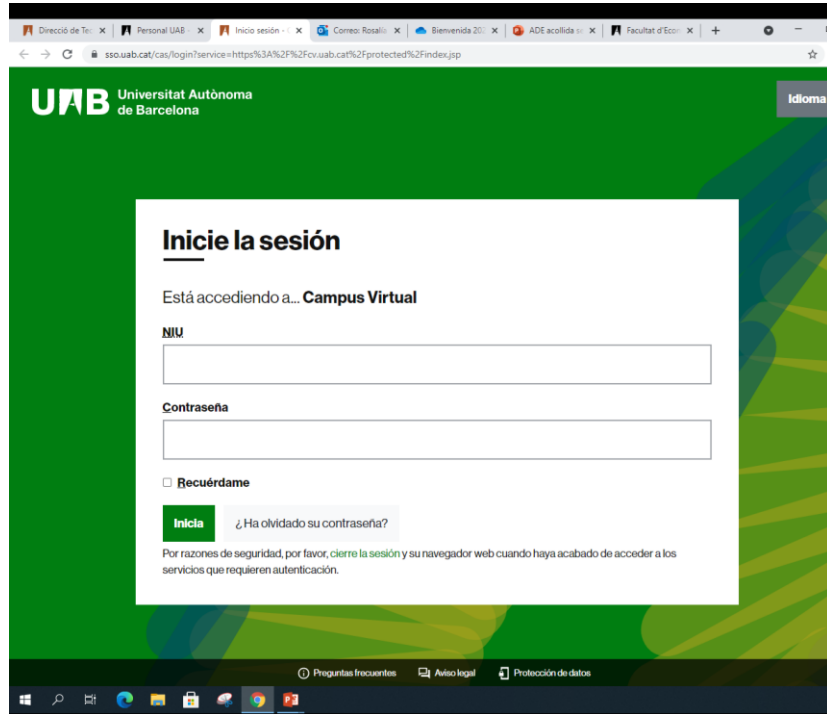
Full time or part time student

UAB students can choose between being a full time or a part time Student. Students can reverse their decision and go back to being a full time Student.

Maximum period of study (time allowed): full time Student 7 years, part time Student 11 years

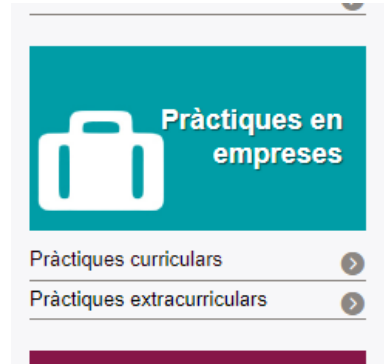
