<b>Prerequisites</b> At the beginning of the course students should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand written texts about everyday topics. (CEFR-FTI A2.2)</li> <li>• Write very short and simple texts on topics related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.2)</li> <li>• Understand short and simple utterances in German on topics related to the immediate environment. (CEFR-FTI A1.2)</li> <li>• Express themselves in spoken German on topics related to the immediate environment using very short and simple constructions. (CEFR-FTI A1.2)</li> </ul>				
<b>Learning objectives</b> The purpose of this course is to begin to develop the communicative competences students need in their C language (German) to prepare them for translating a range of non-specialised texts in Standard German. All course credits are for language skills.  At the end of the course students should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand fairly complex written texts about personal and general topics in familiar subject areas. (CEFR-FTI B1.2)</li> <li>• Write about everyday topics. (CEFR-FTI A2.2)</li> <li>• Understand simple and clearly pronounced utterances in German about everyday topics. (CEFR-FTI A2.1)</li> <li>• Express themselves in spoken German on everyday topics using simple constructions. (CEFR-FTI A2.1)</li> </ul>

<b>Assessment criteria</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading comprehension exercises: 30%</li> <li>• Written exercises: 15%</li> <li>• Listening comprehension exercises: 15%</li> <li>• Speaking activities: 15%</li> <li>• Applied grammar skills exercises: 15%</li> <li>• Coursework: 10%</li> </ul> Students who do not complete a minimum of 75% of all assessed work will not be eligible for a final mark.  <i>These categories may vary from year to year.
