- Nominations are done **via an online form** that will be sent to partners by e-mail.
- **Medicine** students MUST send their Learning Agreement to [intercanvis.medicina@uab.cat](mailto:intercanvis.medicina@uab.cat) by the **30th of June**.

**\*Nominations for Medicine or Escola Massana** must be submitted during this period only, even if the students wish to apply for the second semester. Students will have to apply within the first period too.

# GENERAL APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Students must be nominated by their home university through an online form. Afterwards, students must register and complete their online application through this site: [sia.uab.es](https://sia.uab.es) > Mobility and Exchanges > Incoming exchange students: sign-up and application.

**Learning Agreements** are managed by the **Exchange Offices** directly. Any issues related to LAs should be addressed to the Exchange Offices.

## Applications to Design Studies (EINA & Massana)

Students wishing to apply to EINA School of Design and Art or Escola Massana Arts and Design School must complete an additional application. It should be sent directly to each school:

*\*Please note that other affiliated schools (like Gimbernat or EUSS) can have their own or additional application procedures/requirements (check their webpages or contact them for more info).*

## Important remarks

- **Minimum 50%** of the total credits must be enrolled **at your host faculty** at UAB. The remaining 50% can be enrolled in a different faculty only if there is availability.
- **Admission to Master's level courses:** It is only possible to enrol in master's courses if the agreement between UAB and your home university includes the master level. Moreover, **the coordinator** of the master's must give the **final approval** for your enrolment. Exchange incoming students at Master level can enrol a maximum of 30 ECTS.
- **Thesis:** most faculties **do not accept** students who intend to prepare their **final thesis project** at UAB or do some research for it. Please discuss it with the Exchange Office, and they will assess your case.
- **Complementary Insurance:** A small fee of 4,48€ (in 2023-2024) will be required in order to take out a complementary insurance, addressed to all students enrolled at the UAB, that covers accidents and civil liability.
- **Depending on the faculty**, you will need to complete a **pre-enrolment** on an **online** platform. Just follow the instructions sent by the Exchange Office at your faculty.

# LANGUAGE INFORMATION AND REQUIREMENTS

Lectures are **mainly taught in Catalan or Spanish**. The usage of either language depends on the lecturer who gives the course. Exams can be answered Spanish or Catalan. Only the exams of the courses taught in English can be answered in English). No Catalan certificate is required. Lectures offered in **English** are available on this [list](#).

As a general rule, it is **recommended** that students have a minimum language level of **B1** on the language of instruction of the courses. However, some faculties have specific language requirements:

- **Faculty of Economics and Business:** Minimum level of **B2 of the language of instruction** of the courses selected by the student. List of valid certificates available [here](#).
- **Faculty of Political Science and Sociology:** Minimum level of **B2 of the language of instruction** of the courses selected by the student . Keep in mind that there is a restriction on the number of courses you can attend in English and Spanish, a maximum of 2 subjects in English and 1 subject in Spanish per semester. - **Faculty of Communication:** Minimum level of **B1 of the language of instruction** of the courses selected by the student.
- **Faculty of Psychology:** Minimum level of **B1 in Spanish** to enroll in courses in Spanish and in courses in English as well. Keep in mind that the faculty's offer of courses in English is 2 subjects per semester and the demand to follow these courses is bigger than the room available, so all students should be able to take courses in Spanish too. Exchange students have the right to enrol on an **Initial-level Catalan** course free of charge. Additional Catalan courses and all Spanish courses are also available and subsidised.
